Explanation of Responses:

1. Each share of Class B Common Stock is convertible at any time at the option of the Reporting Person into one share of Class A Common Stock. Each share of Class B Common Stock will convert automatically into shares of Class A common stock, on a one-to-one basis, upon the following: (1) the sale or transfer of such share of Class B Common Stock, subject to certain exceptions specified in the Issuer's amended and restated certificate of incorporation; (2) the death of the Reporting Person; and (3) the final conversion date, defined as the first trading day on or after the date on which the outstanding shares of Class B Common Stock, subject to certain timing criteria.

2. This transaction was made pursuant to a Rule 10b5-1 trading plan adopted by the Reporting Person on October 12, 2022.

3. Represents the number of shares required to be sold to cover the statutory tax withholding obligations in connection with the vesting of the restricted stock units. This sale is mandated by the Issuer's election under its equity incentive plans to require the satisfaction of minimum statutory tax withholding obligations to be funded by a "sell to cover" transaction and does not represent a discretionary sale by the Reporting Person.

4. The price reported in Column 4 is a weighted average price. These shares were sold in multiple transactions at prices ranging from \$14.49 to \$14.60 inclusive.
